In her earlier years, Barbara loved to bowl, participating in leagues in Woolrich, Linden, and Dunnstown.

She was known for her unconditional kindness, quick wit, and fondness for long chats on her front porch swing. Barbara loved having her family at the house and always had ready lots of food, tales of her mischievous childhood growing up in Woolrich, and jokes that had the entire room laughing. She will be remembered for her big heart and infectious smile.
