After graduation, she moved to Lock Haven, Pennsylvania to work at Piper Aircraft, where she was able to obtain her pilot license. While working at Piper, Vivian met her husband, Clarence Junior "CJ" Aungst. Vivian and CJ then partnered with Manynard Aungst to operate the Pine Creek Ice Plant in Avis, Pa. Later, they owned and operated CJ's Inn in Charlton, Pa. In December of 1970, Vivian and most family, moved to Scottsdale Arizona where she retired from Motorola. Throughout her life, she could be best known as a witty, thrill-seeking adventurer who parasailed over the ocean in her 80s, zip lined over the animal reserve at 90, and rode roller coasters at 91.
